

23rd April 1944: Halifax Mk BIII, LV916 EY-C

Information

The construction details for this particular aircraft have not been recorded. The date the aircraft was delivered to 78 Sqn is also not known

The crew were briefed to conduct a training sortie. The ATD of the aircraft from RAF Breighton, Yorkshire was not recorded

For reasons unknown, LV916 EY-C crashed 500 yards N of Sutton Farm, Sutton on Derwent, 7 miles SE of York at 1558
