We took off from MELDENHALL at 2230 hrs on 11 Jun 44.
We baled out at 0010 hrs (12 Jun) in the vicinity of
MEERSELO (N.W. EUROPE, 1:250,000, Sheet 2A and 3A, E 7426).
Here I met an organisation. I went with some members of this
organisation to ARGEN (Sheet 3, E 9221). From there we went
via HORST (E 8419) to GRIENLTSVEEN (E 7218) where we stayed
four days.

On 15 Jun I met F/Lt. Erasmus WARDZINSKY (Poland),
Fighter Command, who was proceeding to FRANCE.

On 17 Jun I was taken by bicycle to a camp of the Dutch
underground movement in woods South-east of EINDHOVEN (E 4218).
Here I met F/Sgt. FUNTER (M.I.9/S/P.G.(-)2561) and F/Sgt.
GRISDALE (M.I.9/S/P.G.(-)2558), F/Sgt. GARDNER (M.I.9/S/P.G.
(-)2559) and F/Sgt. SPARKES.

We were later joined by:- F/O WALKER and Sgt. SHERMANS,
both R.A.F. and Lieut. COOPER and Sgt. KENNY, both U.S.A.

From here on my story is the same as F/Sgt. GRISDALE.
